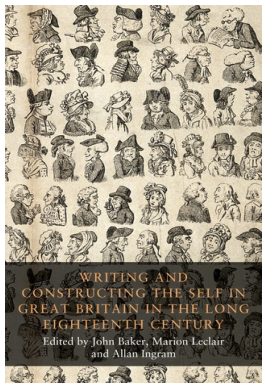


SEVENTEENTH- AND EIGHTEENTH-CENTURY STUDIES

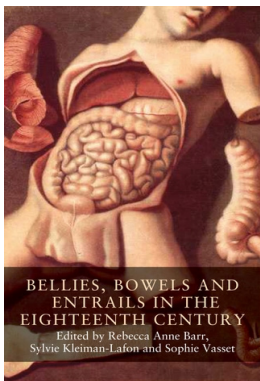

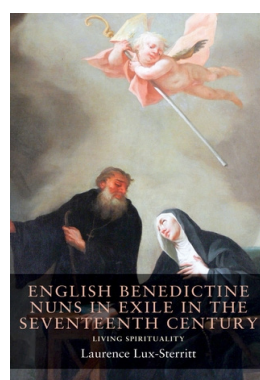
